Agriculture

The Agriculture FDRG will soon be working on the development of a TMC and any needed descriptors not already finalized.

Biology

Finalized descriptors for BIOL 115S and BIOL 130S were posted as well as a draft TMC for vetting until March 31st. Please encourage your biology faculty to respond to the survey.

Chemistry

Descriptors for CHEM 101 (Intro to Chem), 102 (Intro to Organic and Biochemistry) and 103 (Survey of General, Organic and Biological Chem) are posted for vetting until March 15th. CHEM 110 and 120S were updated to provide more specific topic detail.

Communication Studies

COMM 190 (Intro to Persuasion) was finalized and posted to the C-ID website.

Economics

Discussion continues for this FDRG regarding a draft TMC and descriptors.

Engineering

Vetting has just closed for the draft model curricula and descriptors. Feedback will now be reviewed by the FDRG.
