Local Degree Development Notes: Local degrees may not mandate that a student take any course that is not either articulated as general education or articulated as lower division major preparation for the Graphic Design major at a CSU. Additionally, not every local campus will offer all courses or course categories listed on the TMC.

Student Advising Notes: Students must be directed into appropriate elective course choices to match their intended area of focus upon transfer, e.g. Advertising, Interaction Design, Packaging Design, etc., as not all elective choices are appropriate for every area. Local TMC-aligned degree descriptions and patterns should provide adequate direction on course choices for students to ensure that they take the lower division courses prerequisite to upper division courses in their area of emphasis. Students should be advised on which CSUs require a portfolio and on which classes could assist in that preparation. Additionally, in some instances students may be better prepared for transfer into specific CSU programs by taking courses beyond the 60 units required for this degree.
